
TIP OF THE MITT

The newest AVA, created in 2016, Top of the Mitt touches 6 northern counties; producing mostly hybrid/native grapes.

 2017 Waterfire Vineyards, Riesling 59 Sitting just outside of the TOM boundaries, Waterfire produces a mix of Euro and native grapes. This Riesling is dry and appropriately bottle-aged.	
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LEELANAU PENINSULA AVA

Leelanau, the leading AVA in Michigan, boasts a maritime climate due to its surrounding water, moderating temperatures and ensuring fine wine production. Despite occasional frost challenges, it excels in Riesling, Chardonnay, and increasingly, Pinot Noir.

PAULLIAC

Médoc's capital, boasting 3 Premier-class and 18 cru-class wines, among the world's finest

75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot
- **2017 Château Grand-Puy Lacoste, Borie** 135
Second wine of Grand-Puy Lacoste.

ST.- JULIEN

Combines Margaux finesse with Pauillac structure.

- **2018 Amiral de Beychevelle** 125
Second wine of Château Beycheville.
- **2016 Château Léoville-Poyferré** 140
Fresh, silky; layers of sweet berries, cocoa & spice
- **2018 La Croix Ducru-Beaucaillou** 190
Second wine of Château Ducru-Beaucaillou

MOULIS-EN-MÉDOC

This narrow AOC ribbon yields soft, full wines with a supple, delicate character within 300-400 meters.

- **2016 Château Anthonic** 84
Fragrant currant & dark berries. Chewy tannins.
- **2016 Château Cantelaude-Borie** 117
Velvet tannins still give a dry edge to rich black fruits.

PESSAC-LÉOGNAN

Graves, south of Médoc, hosts notable appellations like Pessac-Léognan, known for cellar-worthy whites and velvety Cabernet blends.

Classic blend of Sauvignon and Sémillon
- **2017 Château Carbonnieux** 150
Creamy weight on the palate, with spice, and vibrant acidity.

SAUTERNES

At Sauternes châteaux, growers recount the tale of late harvest brilliance, each claiming their own part in its greatness.

An equal blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Sémillon

ENTRE-DEUX-MERS

Vineyards between Garonne and Dordogne produce value Bordeaux with Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot.

50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 50% Merlot
- **2020 Château Petit-Freylon, Cuvee Sarah** 44
Rustic, rich in tannins with dark black fruits
- **2020 Château Sainte Barbe** 64
Fruit-forward but with pleasant acidity and tannins.

POMEROL

On the right bank and covering just 900 ha, Pomerol carries perhaps more fame per acre than any AOC. Few, if any, can match the uncharacteristic power of its Merlot led blends.

Bright, crisp red fruits abound with an herbal and earthy, lean, simple, red plum finish.

Second wine of Certan.

CÔTES de BOURG

Tannic, full and rustic Merlot balanced with a reputation of a nose of soft fruits.

98% Merlot. 2% Cabernet Sauvignon.

FRONSAC

Strategic elevation brought value to Charlamagne's land. Now famous for powerful Merlot and Cabernet.

Medium to full-bodied with generous black fruits

ST.- ÉMILLION

Robust Merlot with fruity aroma.

- **2020 Château Saintayme** 88
100% Merlot. Nose of black cherries, kirsch, cedarwood, and tobacco.
- **2016 Château des Laurets** 98
Black fruits with well-integrated oak.
- **2016 Château de Pressac** 160
71% Merlot, 16% Cabernet Franc, 9% Cabernet Sauvignon, 2% Carmenere and 2% Malbec.

MARGAUX

Tannic yet soft, perfumed, with less emphasis on Cabernet.

Fine tannins with fresh blackberry and slight notes of licorice and chocolate
- **2016 Château d'Issan, Blason d'Isson** 144
Second wine of Château d'Issan.
- **2015 Château Brane-Cantenac** 290
Juicy fruits with concentrated tannins and cedar-box.

LANGUEDOC & ROUSSILLON

Responsible for 40% of France's wine production, the region offers diversity in style thanks to its Mediterranean climate.

- **2020 Domine de La Motte** 40
100% Pinot Noir.
- **2021 Domaine Penya Rouge** 39
65% Grenache, 20% Carignan, 10% Mourvèdre, 5% Syrah.
- **2020 Château Milou** 40
60% Syrah & 40% Grenache.
- **2020 Domaine de La Motte** 38
Dry, crisp medium-bodied Chardonnay.
Honey and tropical fruit aromas.

BURGUNDY

Home to prestigious Pinot Noir and Chardonnay wines, celebrated for their terroir-driven elegance.

CÔTE DE BEAUNE

- 2021 Mâcon-Pérrone, "Les Gentilhommes" 104
Bourgogne Blanc. 100% Chardonnay.

MEURSAULT

- 2020 Theierry et Pascale Matrot 155
From parcels in Puligny and Meursault. Medium-bodied with red fruit & a brisk black current finish.

BEAUJOLAIS

Renowned for its vibrant Gamay wines, offering fruity and approachable expressions of terroir

BEAUJOLAIS VILLAGES

- 2020 Laurent Perrachon, "Terre de Loyse" 44
A nose of red fruit and flavors dominated by blackcurrants and strawberries

JULIÉNAS

- 2020 Pascal Granger, "Clos de Poulettes" 64
Garnet with scents of violet and a red fruit aroma.

SUD-OUEST

CAHORS

Cahors produces deep, nearly black Malbec, often overlooked in the U.S.

A floral, savory, peppery wine of refinement
- 2020 Château Crocus, L'Atelier 64
Black cherry, raspberry. Ends with firm tannins.
- 2019 Château de Mercuès, Vassel de Mercuès 64
Dark and true to form; with a mouth fond of ripe red fruits.

CORSICA

The island's location and influences shape its rich wine history, with diverse grape varieties.

- 2022 François Labet, Ile de Beauté IGC 44

Not your typical Pinot Noir (100%) as the sea's influence is apparent. A touch of salt and sea-grit on the palate.

CÔTE CHALONNAISE

- 2020 O. Cyrot 84
Cherry, raspberry, spice and floral notes. Supple and balanced, with a firm finish.

CHABLIS

- 2021 Domaine Séguinot-Bordet 132
Crisp green-apple & lemon. Medium-bodied & dry.

RHÔNE

Famous for bold red blends, reflecting diverse terroirs.

VENTOUX

- 2021 Vignerons de Mount Ventoux 36
Floral and fruity, with notes of apricot and peach.

CÔTES DU RHÔNE

- 2021 Château de la Font du Loop 53
60% Grenache, 20% Mourvèdre, 15% Syrah, and 5% Cinsault
- 2022 Domaine de Châteaumar 48
100% Syrah.

CHÂTEAUNEUF-DE-PAPE

- 2019 Château de Fines Roches 96
84% Grenache, 11% Syrah, and 5% Mourvèdre
- 2019 Domaine du Grand Tinel 148
Syrah & Grenache. Dark raspberry & chalky tannins.

LOIRE

A diverse wine region known for its elegant whites, crisp rosés, and vibrant reds

TOURAINÉ

- 2022 Alain de la Treille 56
100% Sauvignon Blanc. Well ripened citrus fruit and lemon marmalade.

CHINON

- 2019 Couly-Dutheil, "Les Chanteaux" 84
100% Chinon Blanc. Medium-to full bodied.

POUILLY-FUMÉ

- 2020 Domaine Serge Dagueneau et Filles 79
Nose of elderflower and gooseberry. Full bodied.

SANCERRE

- 2022 Domaine Daulny 68
100% Sauvignon Blanc. Rich flavors of grapefruit and apple.

VIN DE PAYS

- NV Domaine de la Charriere, Bulle Sarthoise 44
A deep, sparkling rose. 100% Pineau d'Aunis.
- NV Domaine de la Treille, Crémant d'Loire 52
Blanc de Noire. 100% Cabernet Franc.

ALSACE

Michigan's wine climate resembles Alsace, with similar grapes. Unlike other French regions, Alsace labels wines by grape type, not vineyard.

- 2019 Pierre Sparr, Pinot Gris 60
Pointed and lean; yet a noticeable, refined sweetness.
- NV Pierre Sparr, Crémant Rosé 68
Dry toast rounded with red fruit notes.
- 2018 Rêveur, Riesling 68
Rich, yet balanced. Apricot, but minerality persists.

CHAMPAGNE

Look for "grower" Champagnes, made from grapes grown on the same farm

- NV Joël Falmet, "Les Parcelles" 120
Grower. "Brut Tradition"
- NV Jean Laurent 158
Grower. Blanc de Noir; Pinot Noir.
- NV Moët & Chandon, "Nectar Impérial" 160
Softly sweet fragrance of flowers & clover honey.
- NV Taittinger, "Brut la Française" 188
40% Chardonnay, 60% Pinot Noir.

SAVOY

Savoy grows special grapes on Alpine slopes, not often exported but worth trying

- 2017 Domaine Lupin, Roussette de Savoie 56
Per 1988 decree, 100% Altesse.

PROVENCE

CÔTES DE PROVENCE

- 2020 La Fête du Blanc, "St.- Tropez" 48
90% Rolle (a local name for Vermentino) and 10% Semillon.
- 2021 Fleur de Mer 60
Dry with floral undertones; a fine example of Provençal rose.

COTES D'AIX-EN-PROVENCE

- 2022 Bieler Père et Fils, "Sabine" 60
Subtle, dry stone-fruit. Grenache 41%, Syrah 27%, Cabernet Sauvignon 15%, Cinsault 12%, Rolle 5%.

BEAUDOC

- 2019 Mas de Valériole, Famille Michel 56
100% Marselan. True to terroir; light and refreshing.
